RURAL REFORMERS



Rural Reformers envision education for all children in India, increasing the likelihood of employment of our youth thus helping in nation-building. The focus is currently on inclusive education for all resulting in equal education opportunity for every child in India.

Rural Reformers are supporting FourthWave Foundation for School Readiness Program that will enable access to quality education to children with disabilities until these children transition into mainstream education in a phased manner.

SCHOOL READINESS PROGRAM

Accessibility to education for Children with Special Needs is a major challenge in our villages. Children With Disabilities in villages are still seen as the "curse of God" or "a misfortune", grossly neglected, and very often relegated to the four walls of a small room.

Purpose OF SRP

The vision is mainstreaming Children with Special Needs (CWSN) through an inclusive education approach. To achieve this, the NGO, Fourthwave Foundation has been working with the Karnataka government on a program named as "School Readiness Program - SRP".

This program runs from centers located in government selected locations providing -

- Physiotherapy and medical assistance to children with disabilities.
- 2. Coaching on skills needed to be self-sufficient and self-reliant for their day-to-day activities.
- 3. Training to be ready to join the regular school stream.



Short Term Objective

• Sustenance of SRP (School Readiness Program) in Rural Karnataka – For keeping the School Readiness Program (SRP) center in Hubli-Dharwad operational, the NGO needs immediate funds without which the centers supporting 300 Children and staff/teachers will close.

Long Term Objective

• Building Mini – SRP (School Readiness Program) – We are creating Mini-SRPs in Rural Karnataka to reach closer to the children with disabilities where access to quality education is a challenge. Each Mini – SRP will support 15-20 children with disabilities from the local neighboring villages for a period of 3 years to enable and transition these children into mainstream education in a phased manner.

Mini-SRPs

We are creating Mini-SRPs to reach closer to Children with Special needs in villages that will be accessible for the children without the hassle of travelling a long distance(25-30KMS) to reach centers and increase participation.

Two M-SRP centers will function as

- Mini School Readiness Program (M-SRP) Centers - for children with special needs.
- Citizen Literacy Program (CLP) Centers - Adult school in the evening and awareness sessions.
- Specialist Telemedicine (ST) Centers
